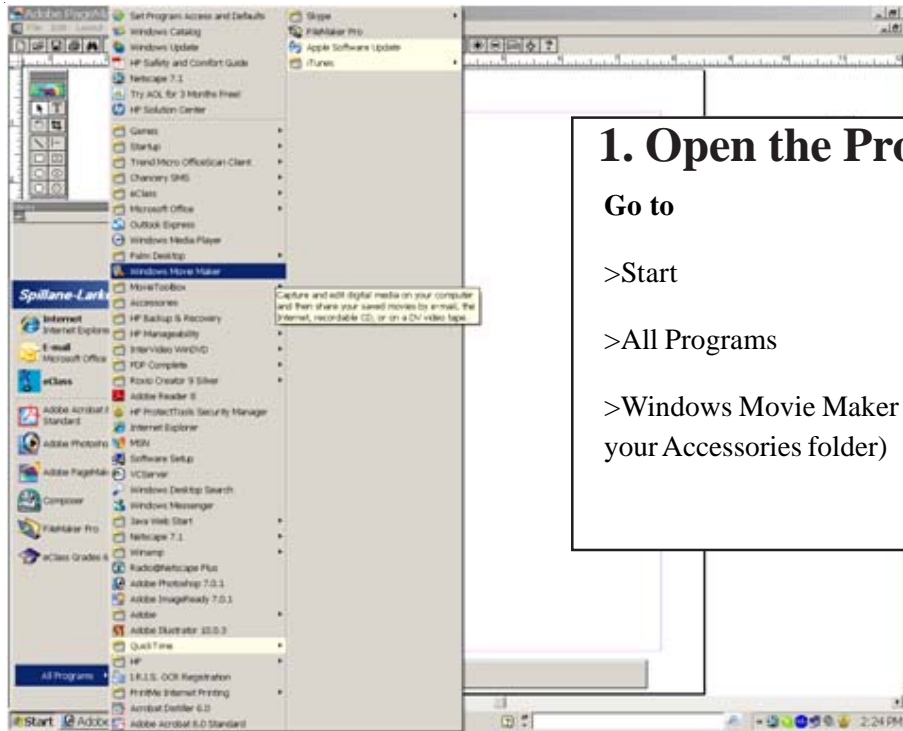

Go to

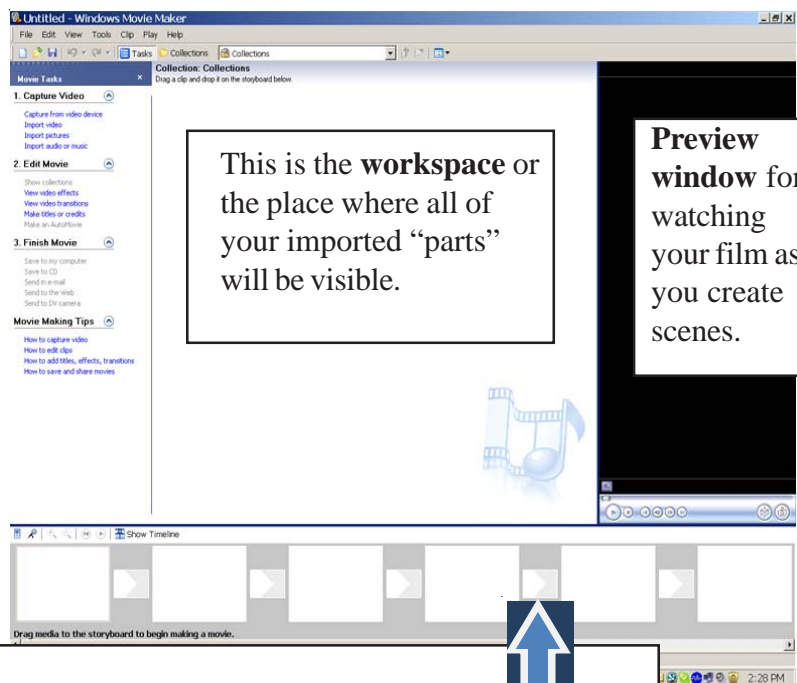
>Start

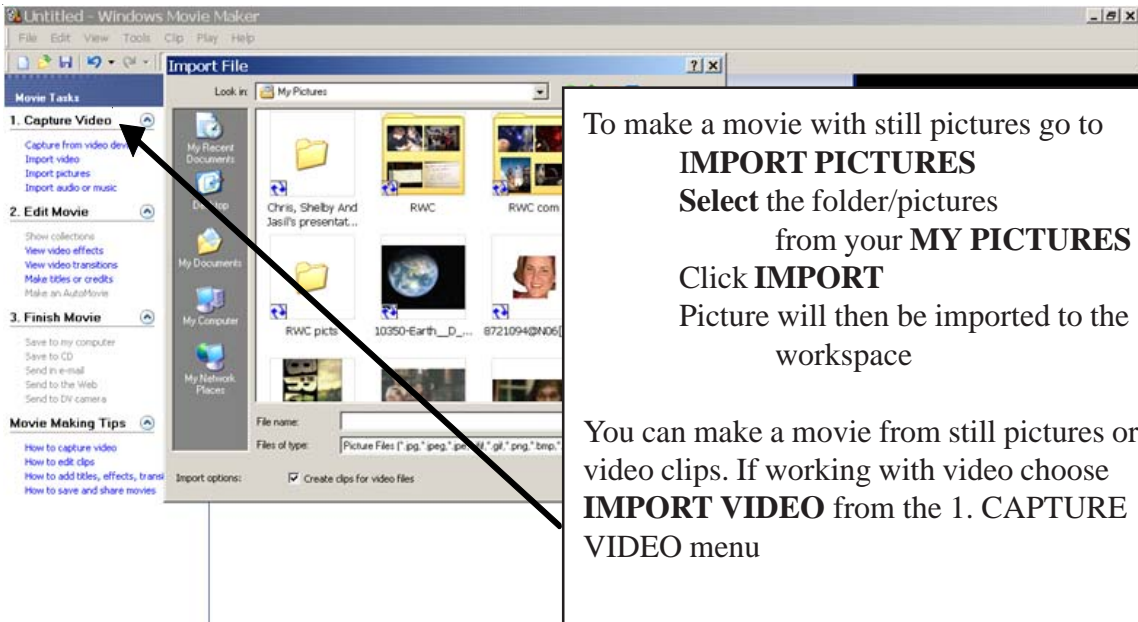
>All Programs

## 2. Get to know the workspace

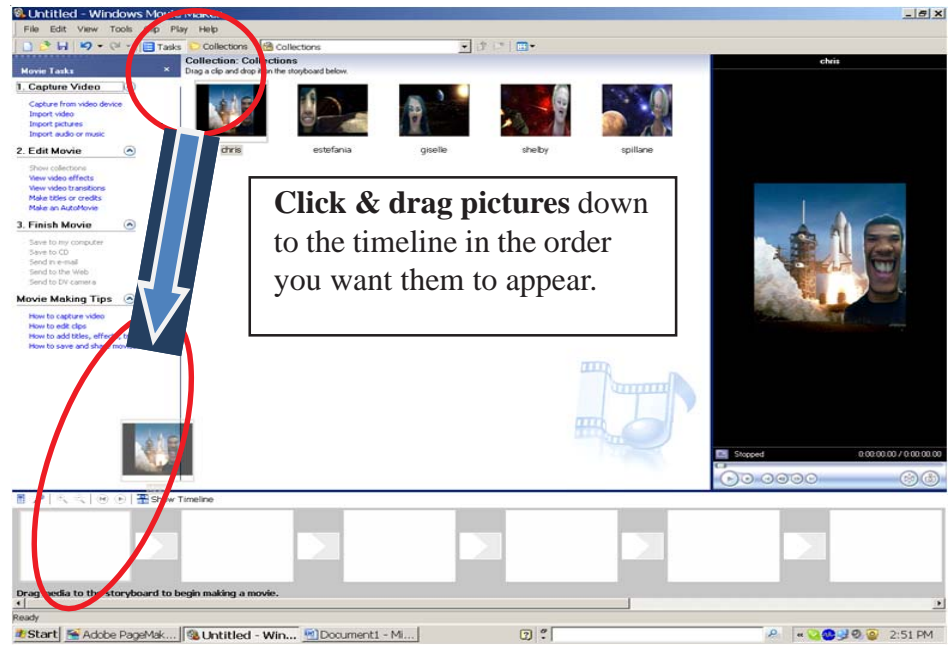
Step-by-step instructions MENU.





To make a movie with still pictures go to **IMPORT PICTURES**  
**Select** the folder/pictures  
from your **MY PICTURES** folder  
Click **IMPORT**  
Picture will then be imported to the  
workspace

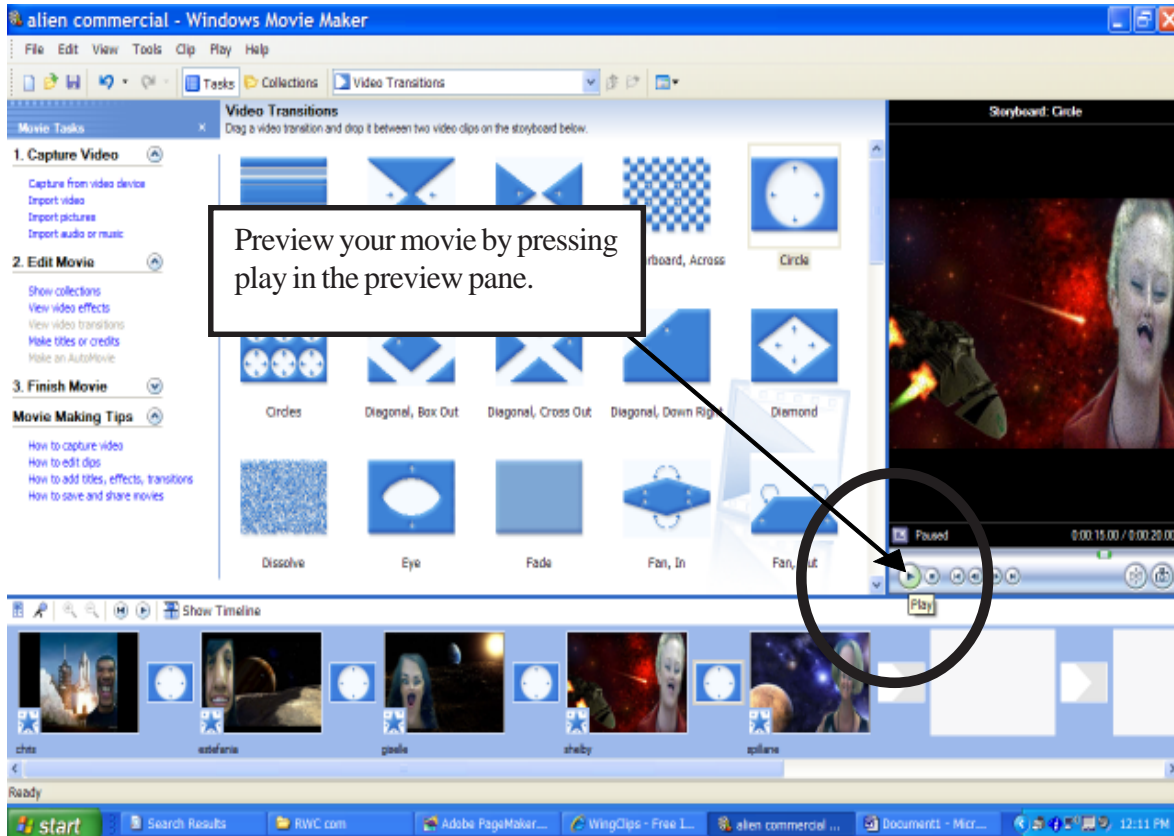
You can make a movie from still pictures or from

VIDEO menu



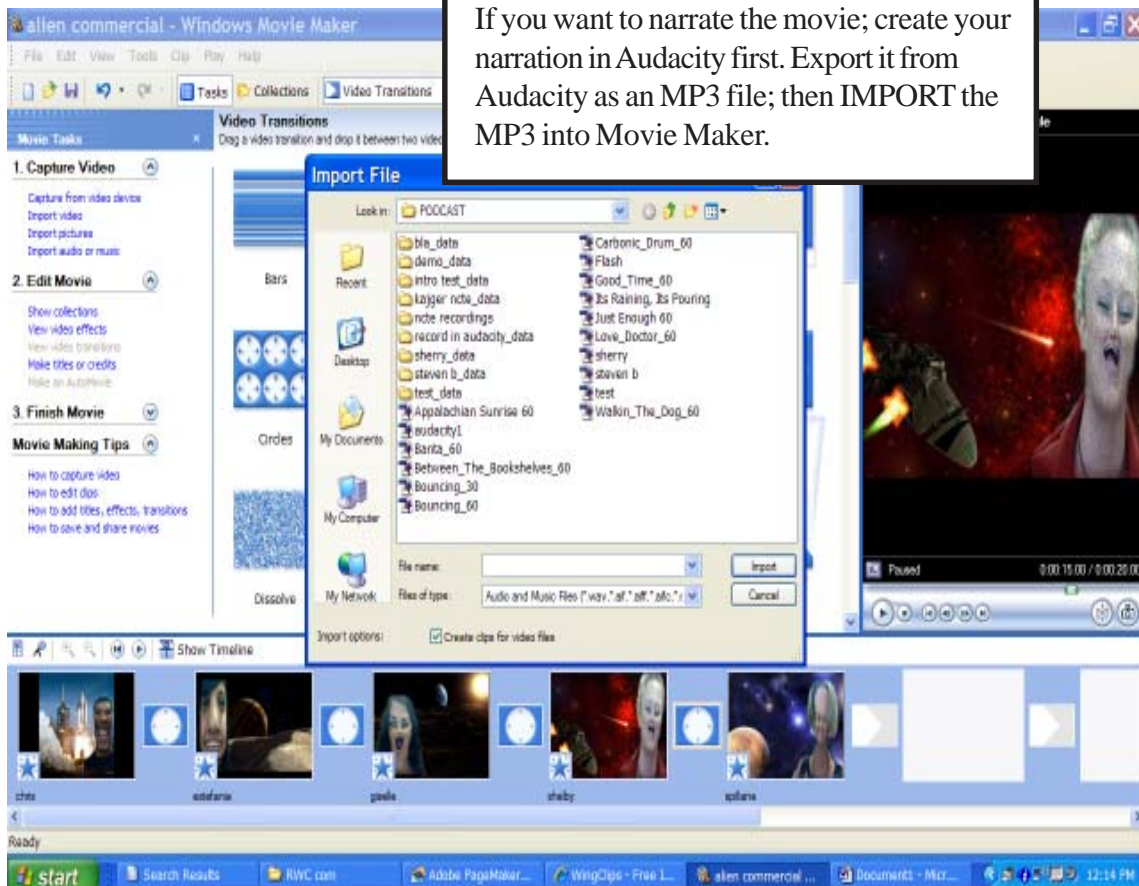
**Click & drag** pictures down

you want them to appear.



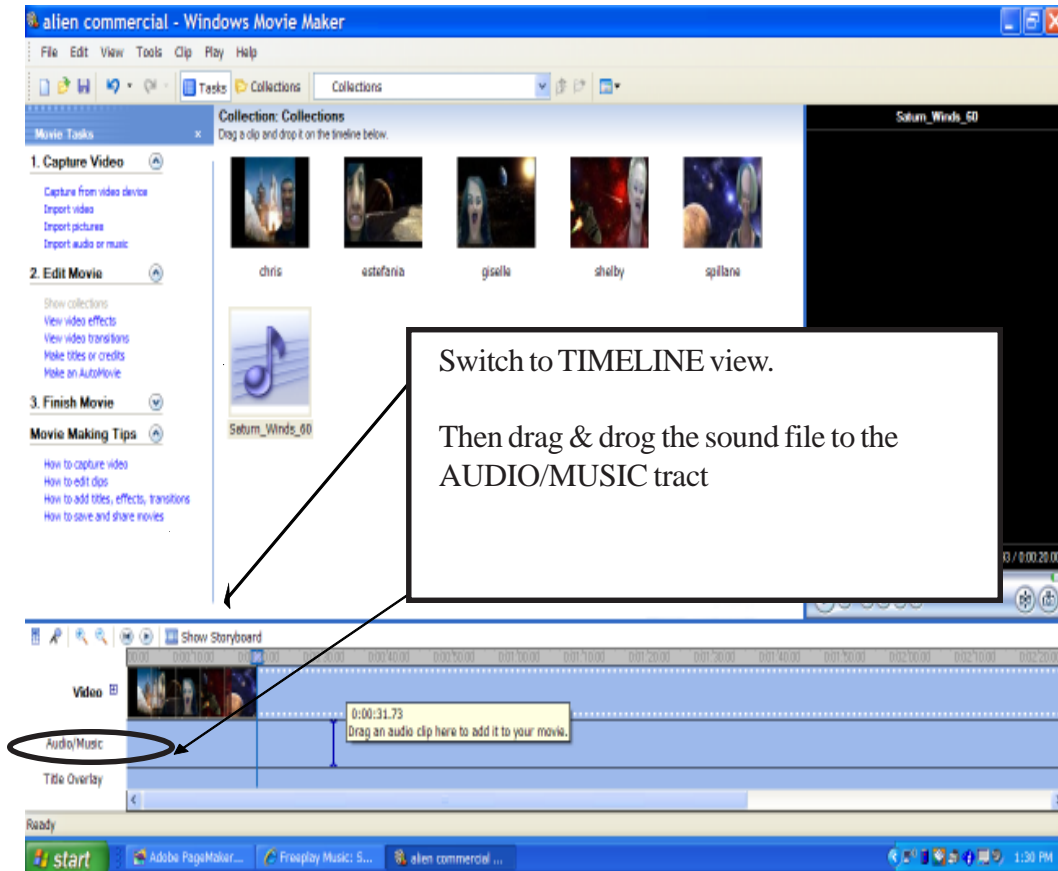

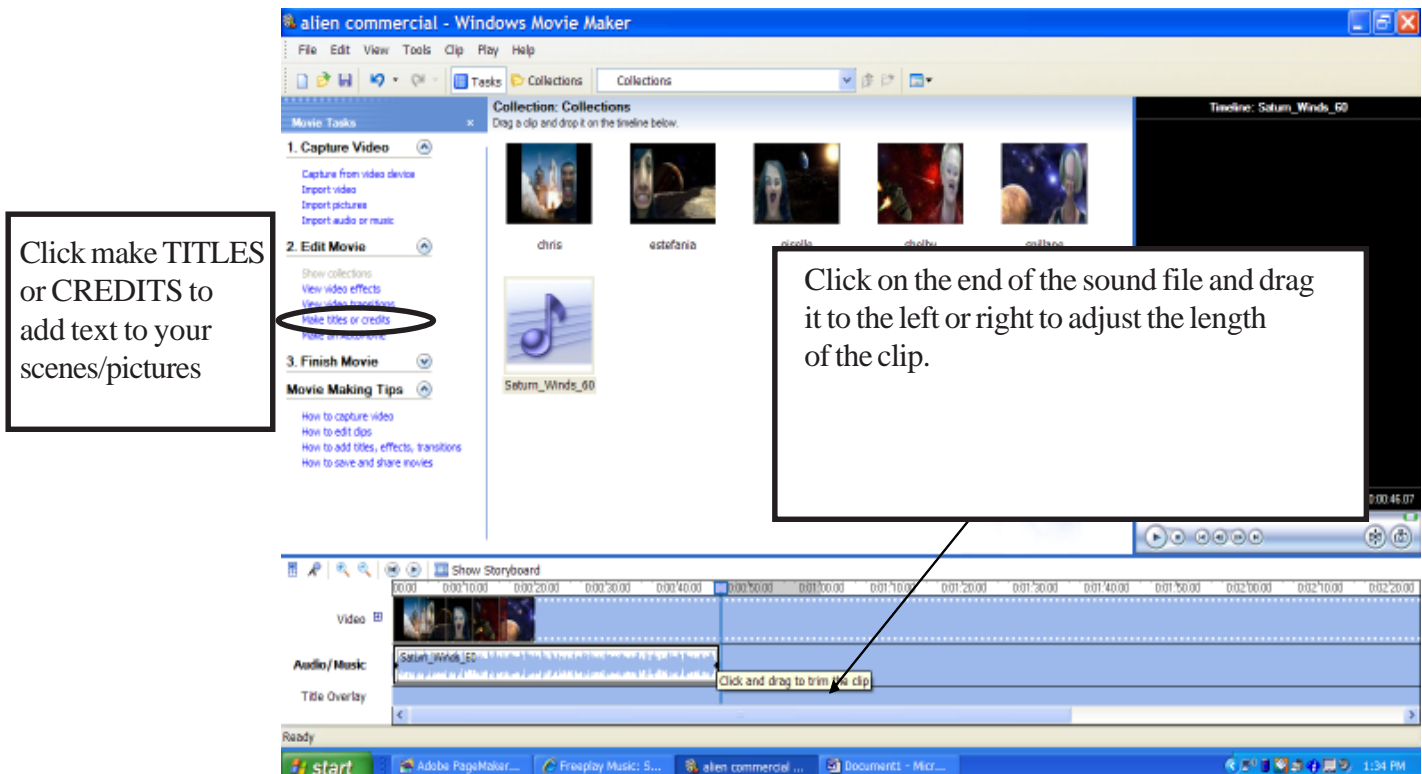

# Switch Your View from Storyboard to Timeline

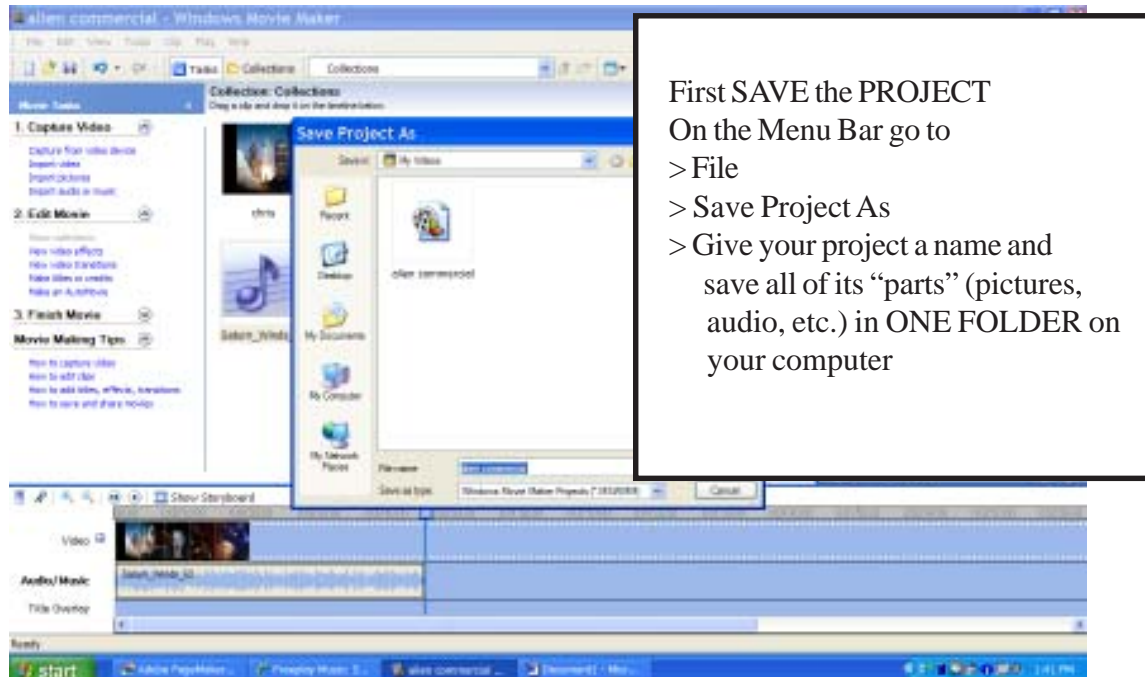


# Edit Your Sound to Fit
